1. Bring your Confirmation Letter to check-in
2. Report at the reporting time stated in your Confirmation Letter. Performers must be READY to perform earlier or later than their actual time.

3. Submit **ORIGINAL SCORES** at the Registration Table in the actual playing order. Tag the starting page of each piece by using sticky Post-it flags. Write your names on your scores. Scores can be collected back from the Registration Table at appropriate times.
4. Music stands are provided. Bring your own footstool if required.
5. Tuning of instruments should be done before entering the studio. Piano is tuned at A442.
6. Rehearsal and practice rooms are not provided. Please contact external music schools/studios to enquire.
7. **Recording studio can be very cold. BRING A JACKET!**
8. **No photography and recording are permitted as it may interfere with the Festival DVD Recording**
9. Participants are encouraged to invite their families and friends to give support. It is also an opportunity for Participants to benefit by watching fellow performers as well as to interact and forge new friendships.
10. **Admission to watch the Festival (18-22 June) is FREE.** Masterclass and Awards Ceremony & Dinner are ticketed. Entry and exit is permitted only at appropriate times during the performance. Out of respect to other audience, children under 6 years old will not be allowed admission.
